RELATIONSHIPS

- Avoid any kind of behaviour that would be destructive or harmful to the lives of others within the academy, the church and beyond.
- Seek reconciliation whenever necessary to keep relationships healthy. This includes being willing to take responsibility, when appropriate, for any mistakes made.
- We would ask that during your time as a student you would not begin any new dating relationships.
- Actively seek out opportunities to bless those in your home, your community and your church family.
- Demonstrate respect, kindness and care in all interactions with church staff and other students throughout the course.

ATTITUDE

- Openness and honesty are core values in all our interactions, but most specifically in our interactions with Mentors.
- Humility and willingness must be adopted, particularly when challenge is being offered.
- Jesus modelled a servant-hearted approach to leadership, and we look to do the same.
- Punctuality and reliability are a fundamental part of the many aspects of our church life. These must be prioritised by students throughout the course.
- Students must submit to the leading of Site Pastors and Ministry Leaders for the duration of the course.
- Deadlines & course commitments must be upheld by all students. This includes all payment deadlines, assessment deadlines & event commitments set as part of the course. This also includes retreat events, HUB evenings, small group & leadership conference.
- Students must look to observe all staff policies for the duration of their time with the LA. This includes policies relating to absence, conduct and disciplinary processes.
