MAIN PURPOSE OF JOB

To perform the fundraising activities necessary to resource the social transformation ministry of Catalyst Vineyard Church known as Transform.

ABOUT THE ROLE

The Transform team is responsible for the services and ministries of the church that reach out to people who are marginalised or disadvantaged. We aim to meet some of the practical needs of individuals and families in our communities as well as to provide spiritual care, worship opportunities and a gateway to the wider church community. We deliver services like debt help, chaplaincy support for prisoners and ex-offenders, gateway worship services, money and budgeting courses, restorative justice courses, parish nursing and our multi-site mobile and fixed location community pantry service known as Storehouse.





We're motivated by our faith and the services we deliver are our response to the call of God on His people and His church to serve the poor and to 'be' as well as speak Good News.

Working as part of a team of like minded people, the successful candidate will feel passionate about the mission of the church to serve the poor and about the issues faced by those who are marginalised or disadvantaged in our communities. They'll be able to embody the heart and vision of Transform and each of the services it provides. They will be able to clearly and succinctly communicate the inequality or injustice faced by the people we serve, how their specific needs impact individuals, families, communities and society in general, the ways in which our services achieve their aims and objectives and how we know they are effective.

The successful candidate will be able to articulate our funding requests in a credible and persuasive way that stands out from the crowd in a competitive funding market. They will be able to capture the hearts and minds of the decision makers through compelling storytelling and they will inspire confidence in our ability and motivation to see lives, and communities transformed in a way that motivates investment in our services.

MAIN DUTIES, TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This role is central to the effective operation of the social transformation ministry of our church and therefore carries considerable responsibility. The core aspects of the role would include:

- 1. Working collaboratively with the Transform team to understand funding priorities for new and existing work
- 2. Researching and identifying appropriate funding streams and opportunities online and within the local community.
- **3.** Applying for grants towards new and existing Transform projects.
- **4.** Reporting on grant expenditure and efficacy when required by issuing grant bodies.
- 5. Networking with local funders and national funders, including local councils.
- **6.** Planning fundraising events and initiatives.
- **7.** Whatever else is necessary to contribute to the smooth operation of Catalyst Vineyard Church

- An ability to communicate at all levels and to tailor communication style for audience
- Ability to speak and write confidently, competently and persuasively about the work of Transform to influence decision making of potential investors who may be oversubscribed.
- Ability to tell the story/stories of the work of Transform in a compelling way
- Ability to leverage the power of storytelling and cases studies that captures the attention and interest of potential funders
- Ability to present data, facts and outcomes in an interesting and compelling way that captures the attention and interest of potential funders
- Ability to research and use findings from associated areas of work or research which support the case for the work of Transform
- Highly motivated and organised with an eye for detail
- Ability to prioritise and manage own time and workload and to work well as part of a team
- Ability to present high quality work on schedule, sometimes under pressure
- Computer literate, including a working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, Access
 PowerPoint and Google apps
- Strong numeracy skills
- Experience of working in a similar role either in the corporate or charity sector
- Flexible, can-do, positive attitude
